

## 1 OHBR Checklist: Hoverflies (Diptera: Syrphidae)

The list of species recorded in the Outer Hebrides (VC110) is derived from records submitted by various organisations to the National Biodiversity Network Gateway. With the exception of records supplied by OHBR, we cannot verify the accuracy of the identification nor whether these species are still present.

This is not a definitive checklist; it does not include species recorded in literature or in museum collections and although hoverflies are relatively well documented in comparison with other diptera, we are still adding new species to the list. If you record a species not currently listed, and submit your record to OHBR you will be requested to supply further information on how the species was identified to enable us to verify the record.

The identification of the species highlighted in blue requires the examination of a specimen at high magnification (10-30 x) usually with a binocular microscope. We are always pleased to help with identification and to offer advice.
